“Son of Confederate General, USNA graduate, retired a General”

Born in Louisiana, 1867, and son of a Confederate general. He graduated from the USNA 1888 second in his class. In 1890 he was commissioned a USMC second lieutenant.

When WWI started, Br. Lejeune was put in charge of the Quantico Marine Barracks. In 1918 he was sent to France, was promoted to Major General. Br. Lejeune received the Distinguished Service Medal (Army) and Navy Distinguished Service Medal, additionally, France awarded him the Legion of Honor and Croix de guerre.

He received the degrees in Overseas Lodge No. 409. General Lejeune is reported to have called his driver to take him to a meeting. When he named the hour of departure, the driver's face fell. 'I was going to ask if I could get off this afternoon, sir,' he said. 'No, you had better come along,' the General replied. 'Yes sir,' said the driver. 'Where to, sir?' 'At the gate in front of the Temple, General Lejeune tarried a moment to tell the driver to be back promptly at seven. 'But, sir,' was the smiling reply, 'I also have been notified to report here this afternoon,' and together they entered the Temple to take their First Degrees.”

Br. Lejeune had nearly 40 years of service in the USMC, including commanding the Army's 2nd Division in WWI, he was 13th Commandant of the USMC, after he retired was the 5th Superintendent of VMI.

Br. Lejeune passed away in 1942. Sadly, his widow could not attend any services, as she was seriously ill, she also would not consent to, or authorize any kind of Masonic services.
