
"Hero of the Two Worlds"

Born July 4, 1807 in Nice. He was an Italian general, politician and nationalist who played a large role in the history of Italy, considered one of the greatest generals of modern times and one of Italy's "fathers of the fatherland".

He has been called the "Hero of the Two Worlds" because of his military enterprises in Brazil, Uruguay and Europe. He commanded and fought military campaigns that led Italian unification.

Br. Giuseppe Garibaldi entered Freemasonry during exile, taking advantage of asylum the lodges offered to political refugees from European countries governed by despotic regimes. In 1844, was initiated in the "L'Asil de la Vertud" Lodge of Montevideo. Br. Garibaldi was eventually elected GM of the Grand Orient of Italy.

He was very popular in Italy and abroad, aided by exceptional international media coverage. Many of the greatest intellectuals of his time, Victor Hugo, Alexandre



Dumas, and George Sand, showered him with admiration. The UK and the US helped him with financial and military support.

On his deathbed, Br. Garibaldi asked for his bed to be moved to where he could gaze at the sea. Upon his death on June 2, 1882, his wishes for a simple funeral and cremation were not respected. He was buried on his farm on the island of Caprera alongside his last wife and some of his children.

His unification of Italy reduced the Catholic Church's rule of several papal states to only Vatican City, hence the likely hostility of the Pope to freemasonry at the time.
