"In the language of the Holy Writ, there is a time for all things. There is a time to preach and a time to fight." Thus ended the sermon of 30-year-old pastor Br. John Peter Muhlenberg as he removed his clerical robes to reveal a uniform in the Continental Army. After church, 300 men of his congregation rode off with him to join General and W.: Br. George Washington's 8th Virginia regiment.

Born October 1, 1746, John Peter Muhlenberg died the same day in 1807.

After hearing Patrick Henry speak the famous words, "give me liberty or give me death," Br. John Peter Muhlenberg approached General and W.: Br. Washington and enlisted. Promoted to Major-General, he endured the freezing winter of Valley Forge and fought at Brandywine, Germantown, Monmouth, Stonypoint and Yorktown. Of such stuff were the Masons of Revolutionary days. Br. Muhlenberg was a member of Lodge No. 3, of Philadelphia.

Br. John Peter Muhlenberg was elected Congressman and Senator.

He was quite as earnest in lodge work as in church activities, and though one of the most amiable of men he earnestly and vigorously combatted every fad, fancy, fiction and peck-sniffery that invaded the Craft.

John's father, Henry Muhlenberg, was a founder of the Lutheran Church in America.

John's brother, Frederick, also an ordained minister and Freemason, was elected the first Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives.

Both John and Frederick served in the first session of Congress which passed the First Amendment. In 1889, Pennsylvania placed a statue of Br. John Peter Muhlenberg in the U.S. Capitol's Statuary Hall. A memorial to Br. John Peter Muhlenberg is located in Washington, DC on Connecticut Avenue. Br. John Muhlenberg is the namesake of Muhlenberg County, Kentucky.
